## Getting to the Marriott Copley Place Hotel

# ARRIVING

## By Air into Logan Airport

Bus. Time: 30-45 minutes. Cost: \$5.00 by credit card only; cash is not accepted. Outside baggage claim at Logan Airport follow signs to "Logan Express." Board a bus marked "Back Bay" which runs every 20 minutes from 6:00 am to 9:00 pm. Alight at Copley Square (do not continue on to Hynes Convention Center, ask the driver if necessary.) Trinity Church will be at your back and Boston Public Library directly ahead. Take Huntington Ave. (to the right of the Westin Hotel sign) and continue straight ahead two blocks to the Marriott Copley. For the return trip to the airport board the bus on Boylston St. near the corner of Dartmouth St. Boston Public Library will be at your back and Old South Church in front of you across the street. Subway. Time: 1 hour or less. Cost: Free (suitable for those who can manage their luggage on stairs). Outside baggage claim at Logan Airport board any Silver Line SL1 bus. At South Station transfer to the Red Line subway (the "T"), direction Alewife. Disembark at Downtown Crossing and transfer to the Orange Line, direction Forest Hills, alighting at Back Bay station. Upstairs, continue in the direction the train was travelling, cross Dartmouth Street and enter Copley Place shopping mall by the doors to the left of Neiman-Marcus. Take the escalator up and continue straight ahead through the mall. At Tiffany & Co. take the escalator down to the Marriott Copley Place lobby.

Taxi from Logan Airport. Time: 30 minutes in normal traffic. Cost: ca. \$40 including tip. At peak times there will be a waiting line controlled by a dispatcher.

#### By Air into T F Green Airport (Providence, RI)

Commuter Rail. Time: Time 1.5 hours. Cost: \$11.00. Departures from Providence's airport to Boston's Back Bay Station occur weekdays only at 9:10 am, 1:10, 3:40, and 10:10 pm. Calculate the possibility of your return in advance at mbta.com. Directions from Back Bay Station follow.

#### By Train or Bus from the South or West

Trains coming from the West (Amtrak, some commuter trains - Framingham, Worcester): Back Bay Station is the last stop *before* South Station. Disembark there and follow the directions below from Back Bay Station to the hotel.

Trains and buses from the South (Providence, some commuter runs) go to South Station From there, take the T (subway).

Subway. Time: 30 minutes or less. Cost: \$2.50. Follow signs from the bus terminal to the train station itself and the subway (the "T"). Purchase a single ride ticket as your convention registration packet will contain a weekly pass. Take the Red Line, direction Alewife.

Disembark at Downtown Crossing and transfer to the Orange Line, direction Forest Hills, alighting at Back Bay station. Upstairs, continue in the direction the train was travelling, cross Dartmouth Street and enter Copley Place shopping mall by the doors to the left of Neiman-Marcus. Take the escalator up and continue straight ahead through the mall. At Tiffany & Co. take the escalator down to the Marriott Copley Place.

Taxi. Time: 20 minutes in normal traffic. Cost: ca. \$25 including tip.

#### By Train from North Station

This is the end of the line for the Amtrak train from Maine and commuter trains from the north (including Fitchburg to the west). They do NOT go to Back Bay. Leave the train and exit the station to the left. The entrance to the T is just a few steps away. Go downstairs and follow directions to the Orange Line outbound to Forest Hills and leave at Back Bay.

### Directions from Back Bay Station to Marriott Copley Place

Disembark at Back Bay station from Amtrak or MBTA commuter rail or the T. Upstairs, orient yourself 180 degrees from the direction the train was travelling and exit the station, using the main Dartmouth St. exit. Cross Dartmouth St. and enter Copley Place by the doors to the left of Neiman-Marcus. Take the escalator up and continue straight ahead through the mall. At Tiffany & Co. take the escalator down to the Marriott Copley Place lobby.

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Trains from the South (Providence, some commuter runs) go to **South Station** (or if you miss Back Bay). From there, take the T: Red Line inbound to Downtown Crossing and change to the Orange Line outbound, getting off at Back Bay. Buses arrive at South Station.

Subway. Time: 30 minutes or less. Cost: \$2.50. Buses arrive at South Station. Follow signs from the bus terminal to the train station itself and the subway (the "T"). Purchase a single ride ticket as your convention registration packet will contain a weekly pass. Take the Red Line, direction Alewife. Disembark at Downtown Crossing and transfer to the Orange Line, direction Forest Hills, alighting at Back Bay station. Upstairs, continue in the direction the train was travelling, cross Dartmouth Street and enter Copley Place shopping mall by the doors to the left of Neiman-Marcus. Take the escalator up and continue straight ahead through the mall. At Tiffany & Co. take the escalator down to the Marriott Copley Place.

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By Car

Driving is strongly discouraged. If you absolutely must, take exit 22 from the Mass. Pike

eastbound. Bear right and follow the signs to the Prudential Center. Above ground, merge left immediately on Huntington Avenue and make a left U-turn at the next light. The Marriott will be on your right in the next block. Plan on \$50 per day to park there. Legal on-street parking throughout the city will be frustratingly rare and short-term.
